



Let's Clean Up Auburn



Here is your chance to clean out the neglected nooks and crannies or that pile of junk that you have been “meaning” to get to! Following are guidelines to help you get the job done:

- Yard waste should be in containers marked "Yard Waste" or in biodegradable paper bags. Yard Waste stickers are available at Auburn City Hall.
- Please make sure all waste is placed near the curb before 7:00 am.
- Please confine all recyclables to the green recycling bin. Additional bins can be purchased at City Hall for \$6.00.
- For an additional \$1.75 per month, residents can purchase a 96 gallon green roller cart. Call City Hall for details.
- Never mix yard waste and trash.
- Residents should call customer service (800) 796-9696 to schedule special pick up of Freon based units at no additional charge. Pickup will take place within 5 to 7 business days.
- If you have large items in excess of 50 lbs., please call Waste Management for pickup. Items are limited to one item per week per residential unit and can be placed at the curb on your normal collection day. Items include:

| Carpeting | Rolled and tied in 4 foot sections no heavier than 45 lbs. |
| Cardboard boxes | May be placed out for pickup, flattened and bundled into stacks and tied with twine to secure. Should be no longer or wider than 3 feet and flattened. |
| Computers | Monitors, desktops and printers are all allowed at no extra charge as long as there is no more than one complete unit (monitor, desktop and printer). Additional items or larger office equipment require bulk item handling if heavier than 50 lbs. |
| Building & Lumber | Reasonable amounts properly contained. |

- Waste Management will not pick up any type of hazardous waste. For disposal information, contact the Bay County Environmental Health Department at 895-4006.

City Ordinance states: Refuse containers shall not be set out for collection prior to twelve o'clock noon preceding the day of collections, and after such receptacles are emptied, they shall be removed from the street by twelve o'clock the next day.
